

Schedule B – Memorials

HERITAGE GARDENS SURREY CEMETERY LTD.

DEFINITIONS

BASE means the lowest portion of a memorial set on a foundation;

DIE means the upper portion(s) of a memorial placed above the base;

FLAT MEMORIAL means continuous monument grade granite, engraved or bronze, memorial set flush with the ground;

FOUNDATION means a continuous granite pad, polished top with sawn edges, set at grade, and that supports a memorial (die and base);

HEIGHT means the dimension as measured from the top to the bottom of the memorial, die, or base, as applicable;

LENGTH OR DEPTH means the dimension as measured from the front edge to the back edge of the memorial, die, or base, as applicable;

THICKNESS means the dimension as measured from the front edge to the back edge of an upright die; and top to the bottom of a flat memorial;

WIDTH means the dimension as measured from the left edge to the right edge of the memorial, die, or base, as applicable;

1. The finished dimensions of an acceptable flat memorial shall be:

a) Flat Memorial	20" (50.8cm) – 30" (76.2cm)	12" (30.48cm) - 24" (60.96cm)	3" (7.62cm) - 5" (12.7cm)
b) Flat Cremation Memorial on a Burial Lot	10" (25.4cm) - 12" (30.48cm)	10" (25.4cm) - 12" (30.48cm)	3" (7.62cm) - 5" (12.7cm)
c) Flat Cremation Lot Memorial	12" (30.48cm) - 18" (45.72cm)	12" (30.48cm) - 18" (45.72cm)	3" (7.62cm) - 5" (12.7cm)

2. Flat Finished Memorial inscriptions and design shall be in one of the following formats:
 - a. A carving on the face of a continuous monument grade granite limited to the finished sizes described above; or
 - b. A bronze Memorial installed on a continuous monument grade granite base limited to the finished sizes described above. The base shall be wider and longer than the bronze Memorial and have a border of at least 1" (2.54 cm) of the base exposed on all sides. Sides of the base shall be smooth sawn or polished, and base top shall be polished granite.

3. A The finished dimensions of an acceptable upright memorial shall be:

4. Upright Memorials;
- Shall have the sides of the base (excluding the top and bottom) with rock-pitch edge finish;
 - Shall have a continuous granite foundation, polished top with sawn edges, set at grade; and
 - Vases and/or statues, if desired, shall be permanently affixed and positioned so that no part extends beyond the length of width of the foundation, and height does not exceed 2/3 of the die height.
5. On a full size burial lot the placement of a full size Memorial shall be set prior to placement of any cremation Memorials.
6. Eight (8) additional flat cremation Memorials may be installed, in accordance with the approved plan of the Cemetery, on any given ground burial Lot where each of eight Cremated Remains are interred over an existing casket Interment, or in place of a casket Interment.
7. Bronze Memorial plaques shall not have letters, figures or ornamentation that protrude 0.75" (1.9 cm) above the surface of the granite base.
8. As per the approved plan, design and specifications of the Cemetery and its section;
- Upright Memorials are only permitted on designated full size burial lots.
 - Columbarium and Mausoleum Memorial shall be purchased from the cemetery.
9. Upon approval of the Administrator the cemetery may allow for memorials outside of the parameters listed about. Application to the cemetery must be made prior to ordering the memorial and will not be accepted without permission and payment of all fees.
